What we sell:

- **Bridge Mats** - Made from hardwood timbers that are bolted together, bridge mats are usually 8" thick x 4' wide x 16-18' long. They are used to cross streams or wetlands with any heavy equipment from 10 - 40 tons.
- **Crane Mats** - Made from hardwood timbers bolted together, crane mats are usually 12" thick x 4' wide and 12'-40' long. Crane mats are primarily used to build pads and roads for heavy crawler cranes weighing 40 to 100 tons.
- **Wedge Mats** - are used to make temporary ramps or solid transition roads between different heights. We offer them from 4-20' long and 6-24" high.
- **Logging Mats** - Made from oak, these mats are 10' wide for loggers who make temporary roads to access the jobsite while protecting the environment and allowing them to take the road with them to the next job.
- **3 Ply Laminated Mats** - Made from mixed hardwood with recessed bolts, 3 Plys are 8' wide for easy transport and are used to make temporary road and jobsite decks. Designed for rubber tired equipment up to 40 tons, These mats are made to be flipped and used on either side.
- **Notched vs Solid** - A notched mat allows for lifting the mat with a chain or cable. A Solid mat has no pre-made lifting point and is moved with a grapple or forklift.
